CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



It's been a busy time at Westbrook over the past few months.

Key construction highlights and milestones include...

- Purchasers in Stage 54A will be excited to hear that civil construction works are now complete.
 Statement of Compliance has been achieved and lodged at the Titles Office
- Stage 55 is also starting to take shape, as the road structure is now starting to be laid down
- Over in Stage 45AC, civil construction is progressing well with sewer, drainage and kerb works now completed and titles expected 1st quarter 2023
- Stage 49, drainage and sewer works are now underway and progressing well
- The first layer of crushed rock for Stage 64 road structures is complete, along with kerb and channel works

CELEBRATE THE FLAVOURS OF SPRING



WITH THIS LEMONY ASPARAGUS RISOTTO

Light and creamy Lemony Asparagus Risotto, with leeks and basil, is full of vibrant colour and flavour, making it the perfect for Spring!

A tasty vegetarian meal, or beautiful base for fish, seafood or mushrooms, it's vegan adaptable and gluten free.

- 1 x bunch asparagus
- 1 x large leek (or white onion, thinly diced)
- 2 x cloves garlic, crushed
- 4 x tablespoons olive oil
- 4 x garlic cloves, roughly chopped
- 1/4 x cup of white wine
- Ix litre of hot vegetable stock

• 1 x cup arborio rice

Pecorino Cheese, Toasted pine nuts

• Extra basil, roughly torn for garnish

• ½ x cup of basil (or Parsley) roughly chopped

for garnishing

• ½ x teaspoon salt. more to taste

• 1/4 x teaspoon pepper

• Zest and juice of 1 x lemon, plus extra lemon zest

ASPARAGUS METHOD

- Bring small pot of water to boil on the stove. Cut the fibrous ends off asparagus and discard. Cut tips off (about 3cm) and set them aside. Cut "middles" into 2.5cm pieces. Take 1.5 cups of the "middles" and set aside (to blanch and blend into a creamy asparagus sauce).
- Add remaining "middles" to tips and set aside.

- In small pot of boiling water, blanch the 1.5 cups of asparagus "middles" (without the tips), until tender and vibrant, about 5 minutes
- Drain, but reserve 1 cup of cooking liquid
- Blend blanched asparagus with reserved cooking liquid, 2 tablespoons oil and chopped basil until silky smooth and set aside

RISOTTO METHOD

- Heat 2 tablespoons olive oil in a pot over medium heat. Add leeks and sauté until softened, about 5 - 6 minutes. Add garlic, cook 2 more minutes, until fragrant
- Add arborio rice and stir to coat for one minute.
- Add white wine (if using) and cook for 2 minutes
- Add 1 cup hot vegetable stock and bring to gentle simmer, over med-low heat stirring occasionally, letting the rice absorb the stock. Continue adding stock, one cup at a time, letting the rice absorb it slowly, each time, stirring often
- · At same time as last cup of stock, add asparagus tips and remaining middles, and cook for 3 minutes until rice is creamy but slightly al dente

- Stir in blended asparagus-basil "sauce", add salt, pepper, pecorino, lemon juice and zest
- Heat gently over low heat for another 1 2 minutes, letting risotto thicken a little
- Divide amongst bowls, garnish with extra pecorino cheese, lemon zest and chili flakes
- For some protein, add 1 x cup peas or edamame to risotto, or top with fish, seafood poached chicken or mushrooms

Serves 2 adults as a main meal or 4 - 5 as a side dish
