Westbrook Construction Update

Notwithstanding lockdown restrictions, it's been business as usual at Westbrook with lots of changes continuing to take place!

In the estate's Northern Precinct, civil construction works in Stage 44 have included the recent finalisation of kerbs, channels and the first layer of asphalting, as well as the commencement of electrical and telecommunication reticulation works. Registration of titles for this stage is currently scheduled for first quarter of 2021.

Civil construction in Stage 57 is also progressing well, with electrical and telecommunication reticulation works nearing completion. Concrete works are also currently underway with the audit and compliance phase for these stage works to commence shortly. Registration of titles for this stage is currently scheduled for early next year.

There's plenty happening at Westbrook right now. Here's our round up of all the latest news from Westbrook, along with some great suggestions for things to do in and around Tarneit & Truganina now the days are a little longer and the weather a little warmer!

In other highlights...

- All earthworks within the estate's railway corridor are now complete and final topsoiling works are underway. Earthworks along the Forsyth Waterway in the Northern Precinct are also progressing well
- Residents and visitors to Westbrook's
 Southern Precinct will see that construction
 of the pedestrian bridge over the Forsyth
 Waterway is advancing; structural piers are
 currently in the process of being installed, with
 the actual bridge expected to be craned into
 place before year's end. Landscaping works
 within this section of the channel are also set
 to commence shortly
- The installation of entry statement structures at each of the estate's Northern and Southern Precinct interfaces along Morris Road kicked off recently, with structural footings now in place. At this stage, it's anticipated that installation, including lighting, will be finalised by Christmas

- The Morris Road overpass is in the process of undergoing site preliminary works, with completion still on schedule for early 2022
- Leakes Road has also undergone some major aesthetic changes, with landscaping works including the installation of turf, street trees and groundcover planting due for completion in the coming month
- Westbrook residents and especially those with young families, have welcomed the recent opening of the new Heyfield Drive Park in the Northern Precinct
- And in more good news, Dohertys Road can now be accessed by Alcock through Albright Estate, providing convenient access to the future Truganina Garrang Wilam Primary School.
