Werribee Pop Up Park

One of the best places to celebrate balmy summer days and nights is at Werribee City Centre's free Pop up Park, which runs from 10 January – 2 February 2020.

Each weekend, the free Friday Night Live concert series will showcase some of Australia's best musical talent including Pete Murray, eighties powerhouse the Eurogliders, ARC (featuring members of Spiderbait, Jet, Powderfinger and You Am I) and the legendary Joe Camilleri and The Black Sorrows – all guaranteed to get your toes tapping!

On Saturdays the Park will be transformed into an Outdoor Cinema with lots of new family releases screening each weekend at the child-friendly screening time of 6pm. Come down early for lawn games and free kids craft from 3pm – 6pm and enjoy those warm summer evenings out on the lawn. Each Sunday the Park will host the Sunday Fundays market, with lots of great market stalls, food and lawn games on offer, while weekdays will see it buzzing with free community classes and workshops.

A green city oasis, with comfy deckchairs, umbrellas and lawn games, the Pop Up Park is your must-visit destination this summer.

AquaPulse, Hoppers Crossing

Whether you want to learn to swim, reach a health and fitness goal, entertain the family or just sit and relax in the cafe, AquaPulse at Hopper Crossing has something for you, and is the perfect place to cool down on hot summer days!

Just a short drive down the road from Westbrook, AquaPulse features a huge variety of fun, fitness and health services and facilities. Check out the huge indoor aquatic and leisure centre, with enough slipping, sliding and swimming activities on offer to keep the kids entertained for hours!

Little ones will love the fantastic Aquatic Playground, which features twin slides, two tube slides, water cannons, water spray features, tipping cones and a giant tipping bucket which creates a massive wash of water to the delighted shrieks of those waiting below, while older kids and adults are guaranteed to experience plenty of thrills on the two giant waterslides (said to be the biggest in Victoria!) which snake their way along the outside of the building.

With five pools in total, plus a gym, sauna, creche, kindergarten, shop and café, AquaPulse is calling your name this summer. So grab your swimmers and a towel and head on down.

WESTBROOK - 2019 WRAP UP!

The New Year has now arrived but the last 12 months have been significant ones for Westbrook.

In the Southern Precinct almost 185 new homes have been completed over the last year, which has seen almost 500 new residents moving in and now calling Westbrook home.

Even better, the first residents are now starting to move into their new homes in the Northern Precinct. And with 115 new homes currently under construction, it won't be long before more new neighbours join them!

Residents and visitors to Westbrook can also celebrate the recent achievement of some other great milestones in the past couple of months.

Most significant of these, the northern carriageway along Leakes Road was officially opened on 15 November, just in time for the summer holidays, with overall completion of the duplication works still on schedule to be completed in April 2020. The new 1.5 kilometre section of road, covering the two intersections between Alcock Road and Skeleton Creek Road, is expected to significantly improve commuter times, which is great news for the estate's planned 4,000+ residents and passing traffic.



And if that isn't enough to put a smile on the face of Westbrook's residents, the construction of the Skeleton Creek Bridge and upgraded intersections along the estate is now completed, with 65 culverts now installed along Forsyth Creek to ensure the continued success of the creek ecosystem and waterway, benefiting the entire community.
