

Winter may be here, but there's plenty happening at Westbrook right now

Here's our round up of all the latest news from Westbrook, along with some great suggestions for things to do and see in and around the City of Wyndham in the coming months.

Westbrook's Southern Precinct parks

In good news for lovers of the great outdoors, construction on the two eagerly awaited parks in Westbrook's Southern Precinct are nearing completion, with both opening to the public soon.



The two new open spaces, on Latitude Promenade and Picnic Street, have been designed with residents of all ages and physical abilities in mind. Between them they feature over 200 mature trees complemented by extensive plantings of native shrubs, delivering two great recreational spaces guaranteed to appeal to Westbrook's growing community.

Located just off Leakes Road, on the corner of Latitude Promenade and Society Boulevard in Stage 1, the Central Reserve is spread over two acres. Looking out over Forsyth Waterway and offering up picturesque views of Melbourne's city skyline in the distance, the park features sheltered seating, BBQ facilities, free WiFi, a children's play zone, a scooter track and bowl and a large kickabout space.

The smaller Pocket Park can be found on the corner of Montmartre Drive and Picnic Street in Stage 2 of the development. As with the Central Reserve, it features a custom designed shelter and plenty of fun play equipment for kids, free WiFi, with the smaller more intimate setting expected to appeal to families with young children.

Leakes Road duplication on the way

Westbrook residents are set to benefit from major upgrades to Leakes Road, with essential road duplication works about to commence.

Running the full length of Westbrook's Southern Precinct, Leakes Road is one of Truganina's key thoroughfares, carrying an estimated 23,000 cars each day. The roadworks will see the current dual carriageway widened to two lanes in each direction, significantly increasing Leakes Road's capacity and delivering locals with reduced travel times, more efficient traffic flows and greater connectivity with surrounding areas.

Contractors engaged by Dennis Family Corporation will carry out construction of the initial 15 km stretch of new road between Skeleton Creek and Alcock Road

directly adjacent to Westbrook, with completion of the works expected to take around 20 months. VicRoads will also begin duplication works to the remaining sections of Leakes Road, between Derrimut Road and the Princes Freeway, later this year.

Other important projects about to get underway at Westbrook in coming months include the relocation of overhead power lines underground along Alcock Road and to the north, the upgrade of the Dohertys Road and Morris Road intersection is well underway and is expected to be completed in the coming months.
